

OKEFENOKEE PALE MALT



Two Track Malting is pleased to bring you our signature 2-Row Okefenokee Pale Malt. Okefenokee Pale Malt pays tribute to our Grandfather Paul Stober for a pond that never seemed to dry out. He always wished this swamp land would dry up so he could plant more grain, but even to this day the pond survives.

This malt was made from Pinnacle Barley which was harvested on August 2015 by farmers John and Donovan Stober. The Stober Farm is a 6th generation family farm located in Goodrich ND which has been producing the highest quality grains for over 100 years. This specific batch of malt was grown on the Konshack 80 field about a half mile away from the Stober farmstead. (See satellite photo below).




Growing Day Units are a measure of heat accumulation used by farmers to predict development rates to determine when a crop will reach maturity.
